Flex = Flexible Schedule!

- Flex is every day after 3rd block and is about 35 minutes in length.
- Flex is a study hall for you to get homework or make-up work completed, ask teachers for help, retake a test or quiz, read your book, etc.
- It is also a time when we have monthly clubs, SEL and character lessons, team meetings, and grade level assemblies.
- Your flex teacher will be one of your team teachers or an elective or PE teacher assigned to your team.

HOMEWORK???

- Yes, we give homework!
- You will most likely have anywhere from 20-40 minutes each night, but you will have flex (like a study hall) every day where you can work on homework, so you could go home having finished it!
- Homework is practice and most of your core content teachers will assign it each class.
- All of your classwork and homework assignments will be posted in Schoology in each teacher's course.
- SUPER IMPORTANT: Students should do homework the <u>night it is assigned!</u> That way if you need help or more time, you have an extra day for most of your classes. (Math & Language Arts meet every day.)

Health and PE (Gym!) YES NO

- You have the option to change into athletic clothes that you would bring from home.
- · You do have to run.
- · You will have fun!

- You will not run all period long.
- You do not have PE every day; it meets every other day.
